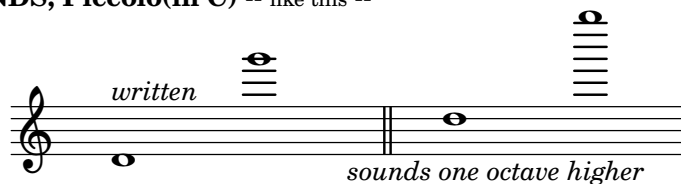

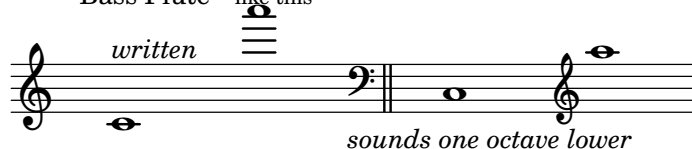
INSTRUMENT RANGES
